Overview

Under existing regulations, the FRPCC is now composed from 20 Federal Departments, agencies, and offices that work together to assure that the United States is safe from radiological incidents, involving nuclear or radioactive materials, including acts of terrorism.

The FRPCC is a national-level forum for the development and coordination of radiological prevention and preparedness policies and procedures. It also provides policy guidance for Federal radiological incident management activities in support of State, tribal and local government radiological emergency planning and preparedness activities. The FRPCC is an interagency body consisting of the coordinating and cooperating agencies discussed in this Nuclear/Radiological Incident Annex (NRIA), chaired by DHS/FEMA.

The FRPCC coordinates research-study efforts of its member agencies related to State, tribal and local government radiological emergency preparedness to ensure minimum duplication and maximum benefits to State, tribal and local governments. The FRPCC coordinates planning and validating requirements of each agency, reviewing integration requirements and incorporating agency-specific plans, procedures, and equipment into the response system.

As part of their preparedness for nuclear/radiological emergencies, Federal agencies participate in exercises to test and evaluate response plans.
